
GRADE 5 WARM/COOL COLOR ART PROJECT


5th Grade Students:

Attached is a copy of the art project we created in tech class using "Paintbrush".




- 1. Your design was to be divided into 7 "pie" sections. You are to color alternating sections with warm colors (reds, oranges, yellows). The other sections will be in cool colors (blues, violets, greens). For example: Sections 1, 3, 5, & 7 can be cool; sections 2, 4, & 6 can be warm.
