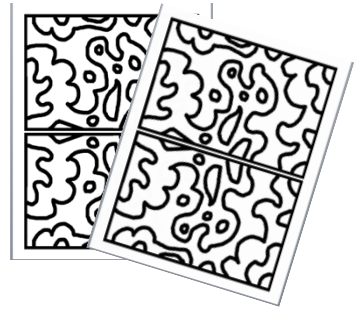


# GRADE 6 COLOR SCHEME ART PROJECT

Also attached is a sample color wheel for you to use if needed.







4. Please take a picture of your finished art and attached it here or email it to me.

Choose any four of these 6 color families for your project:

1. Primary Colors	2. Secondary Colors	3. Analogous Colors
RED-YELLOW-BLUE	ORANGE-GREEN-VIOLET	(up to) 4 neighboring colors on the color wheel – example: blue-green, green, yellow-green, & yellow
		
4. Tertiary Colors	5. Neutrals	6. Monochromatic
Red-orange, yellow-orange, yellow-green, blue-green, blue-violet, & red-violet	Shades of gray and brown	Shades (like maroon & forest green) and tints (like pink & sky blue) of any one primary or secondary hue (such as all different greens, blues, reds, etc)
